

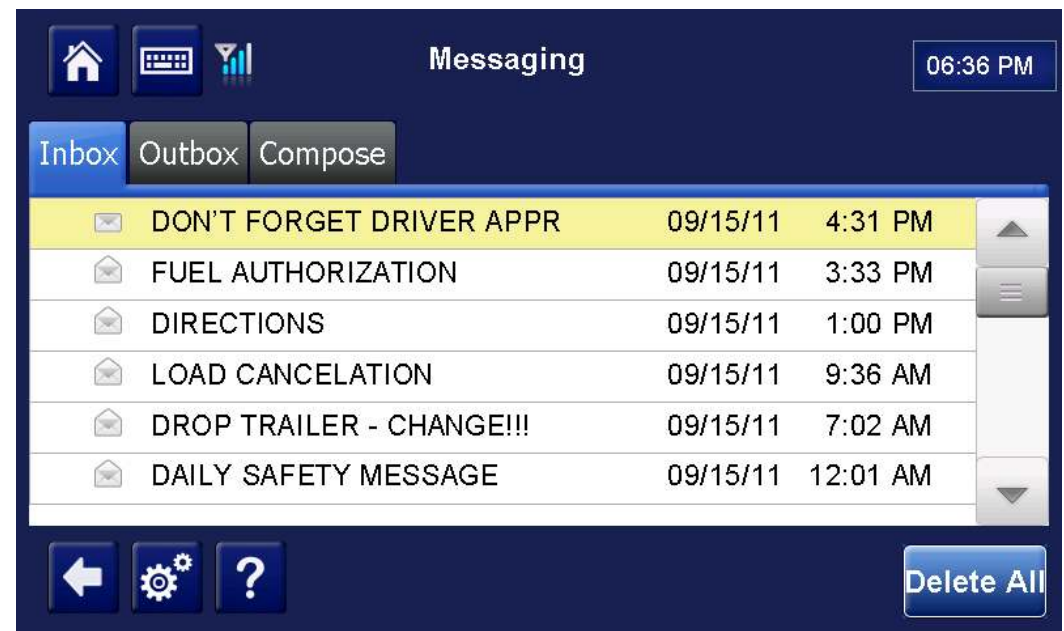

# Messaging and Macros

- Sending and receiving information is the most common task performed on the DIU50.
- You need to know how to:
  - Recognize that new information has arrived.
  - Read the information.
  - Reply to it.
  - Use macros to save time and improve accuracy.



# Receiving Information

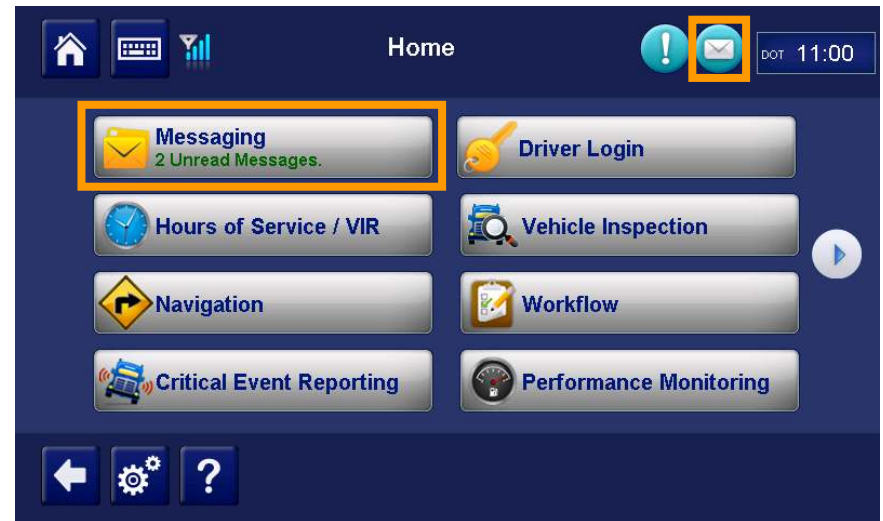
- Information automatically arrives when the ignition is on and for a short time after the ignition is turned off.
- Starting or idling your vehicle is not necessary.
- Information is stored until you are ready to read it.
- When you are sleeping, you can turn the volume down completely for both alerts and voice.



**Turn the volume back up when you get behind the wheel!**

# How Do You Know If You Have a Message?

1. The DIU50 plays an alert.
2. Text-to-speech tells you.
3. A mail icon appears at the top of the display.
4. The Messaging button shows "N Unread Messages."



NOTE: The envelope icon at the top appears when a new message is received, regardless of which screen you are viewing.

# If You're Moving When You Get Alerted

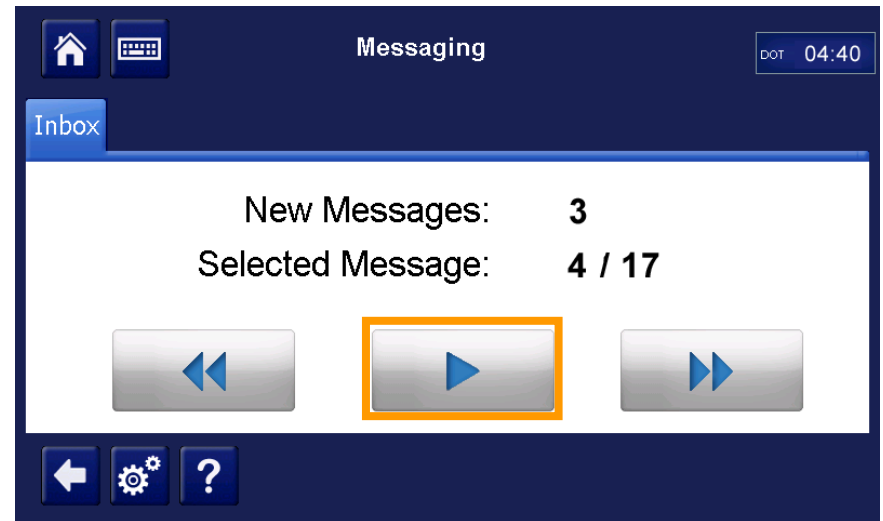
You see a summary after selecting your inbox.

You can:

- Tap the play button
- Tap the forward and backward arrows to play other messages

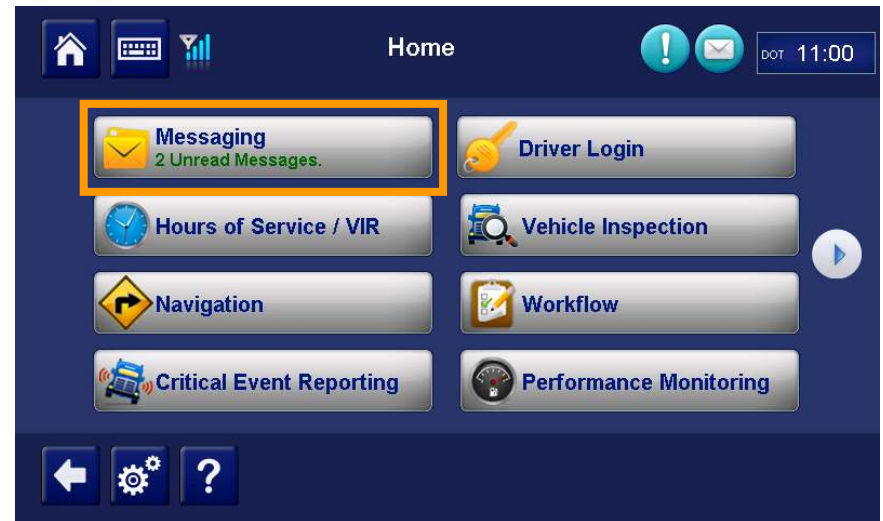
After you stop, you can:

- Read information and reply to it
- Create new freeform or macro messages and send them
- Check your outbox for information you sent

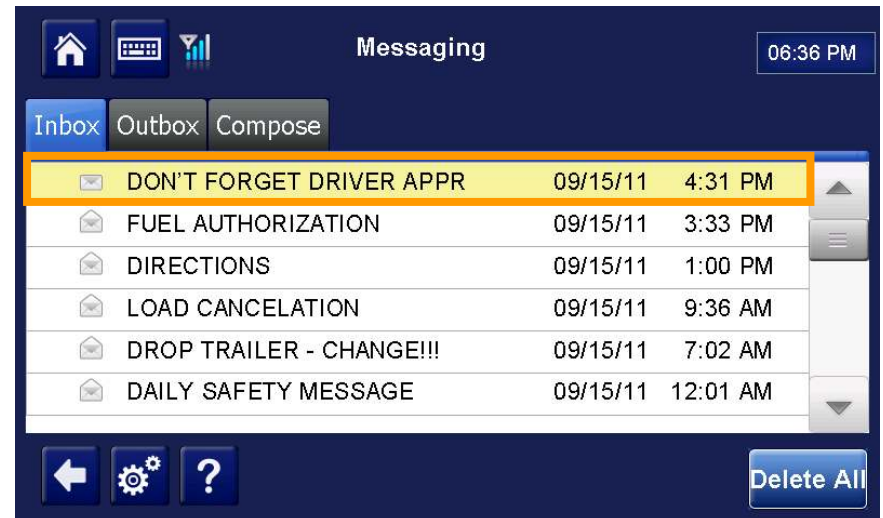


# Read a Message

1. Tap the Messaging button.

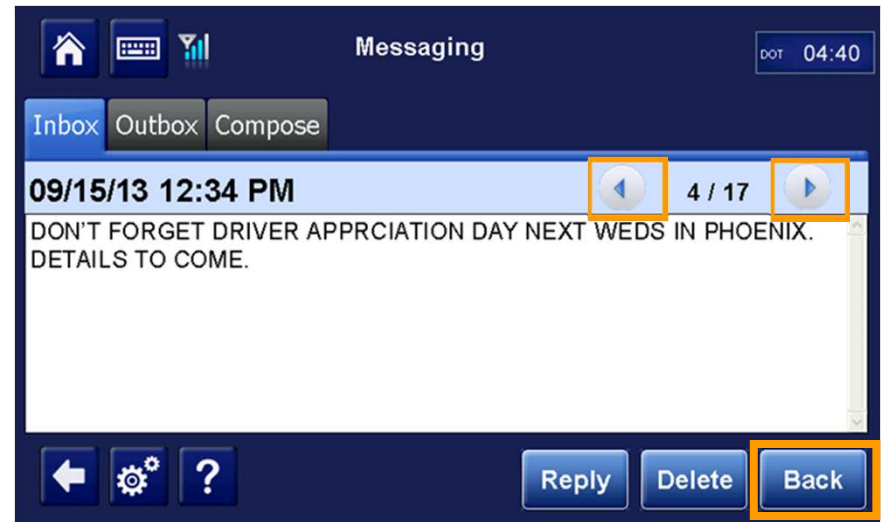


2. Tap the message you want to read.



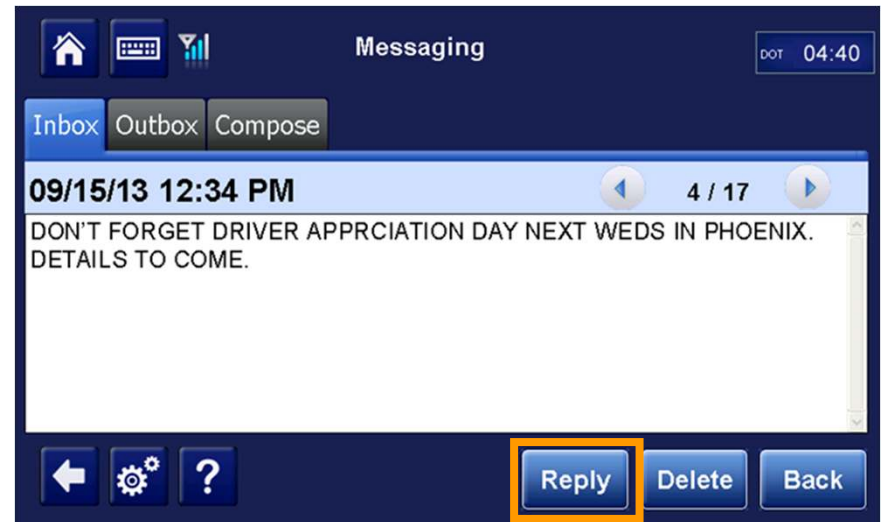
# Read a Message

3. Read the message. Scroll down as needed if the message is long.
4. To read the next or previous message, tap one of the arrows.
5. To return to your inbox, tap the Back button.

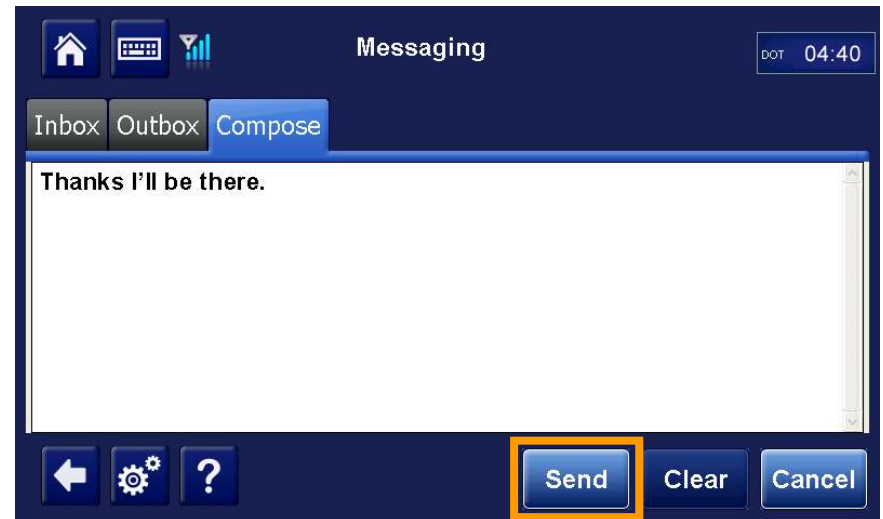


# Reply to a Message

1. Tap Reply.



2. Type your message.



3. Tap Send.



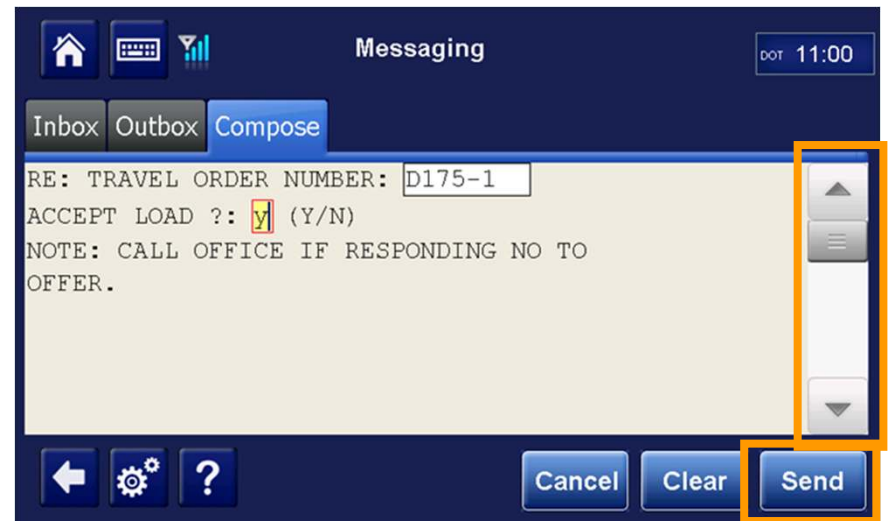
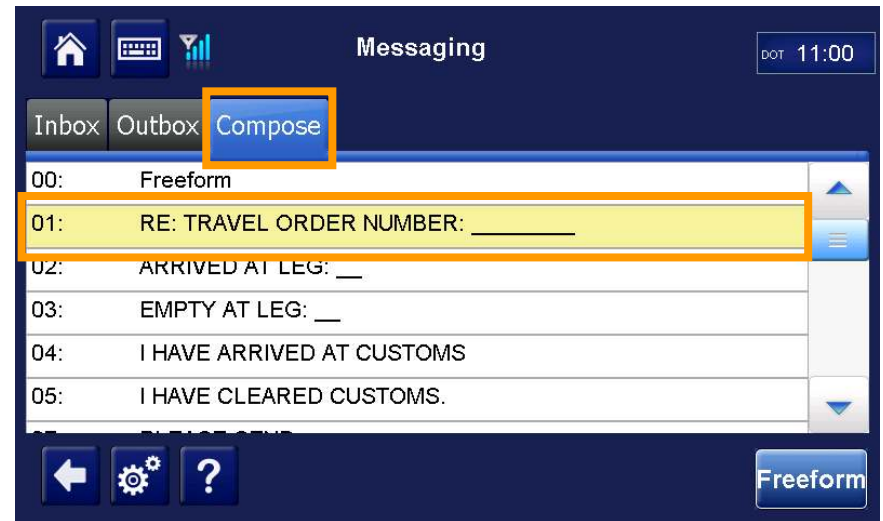
# Reply to a Message

4. Tap Yes to confirm.



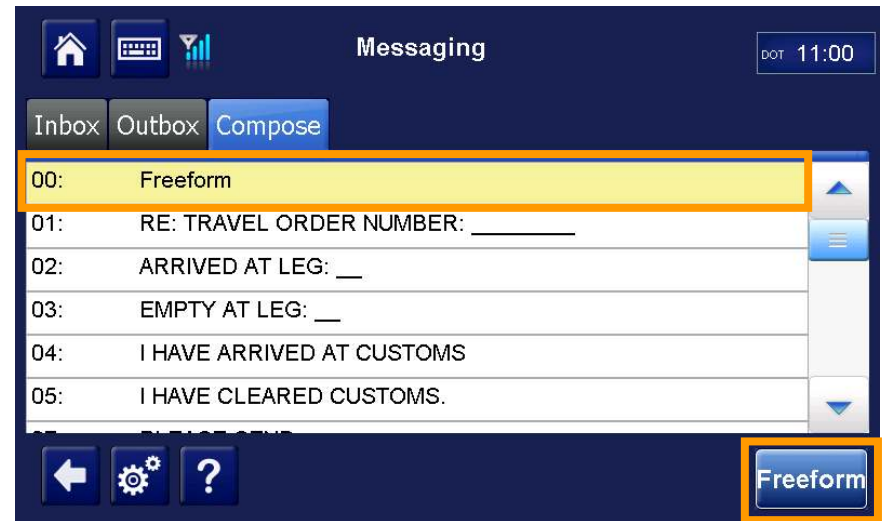
# Send a Macro

1. Tap Compose.
2. Select a macro. You may need to scroll to find it.
3. Tap inside each box, and then type its data.
4. Scroll down as needed to complete the message.
5. When you're finished, tap Send, then tap Yes to confirm.



# Send a Freeform Message

1. On the Compose tab, tap Freeform in the list or tap the Freeform button.



2. Type a message.
3. Tap Send, then tap Yes to confirm.
